GOVERNMENT'S SEND REFORM PROPOSALS:

WHAT WE'VE GOT

EHCPs in mainstream that support children with high needs to stay in their local school

If your child can't manage a mainstream class, an inclusion base with an EHCP is a choice you can refuse.

An EHCP based on individually assessed education, health and care needs.

The right to request a specialist placement that meets needs



WHAT WE'LL GET

A duty for an individual support plan but NO legal right to the provision and no appeal rights—only a school complaints process.

If your child can't manage mainstream, the school can move your child to an inclusion base without an EHCP or a legal appeal right

An EHCP based on one of 7 nationally set provision packages. What if your child doesn't "fit" in a package?

The LA will decide the placement. A successful appeal will only mean the LA has to decide again.
